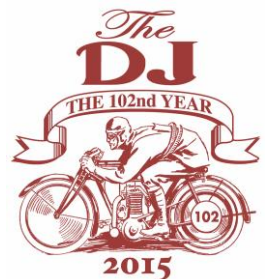

Foreword

As the new Chairman at the Vintage and Veteran **Club**, I am truly proud to be able to write this foreword for the 102nd DJ event taking place in March. Next year I hope to write the 103rd foreword *and* participate in my first DJ Event.

Over the last few years as I have involved myself in committee affairs at the Club, I have been amazed at the extent of work that goes into the preparation of this annual historic event. The organisers are always faced with so many road and logistical challenges yet despite these issues, the final plan always comes together to make another memorable event and I have no doubt that 2015 will be just as successful as the past events.

Recently, I was given historic DJ publications and media material to scan and archive for future generations to enjoy. One hundred years ago the event was not run due to the war and only resumed in 1919. As I paged through the material, I tried understand the challenges that riders faced back in those days. In 1913 the bikes must have been almost new but still less reliable than those same bikes today. There were no highways, no fuel stops, no conveniences stores and, no doubt, all gravel corrugated roads. To make it worse, there was a fine of 10 pounds and possible imprisonment for failing to close a farm gate. If you got stuck, you would have been lost for days. Thus 3 days to get to the coast from Johannesburg must have been quite an ordeal and a big sense of achievement in that era.

For the last few years where the event finished in Johannesburg I would not miss the finish line event seeing the exhausted riders make the final leg to the finish line putting two feet down? The difference from the old days where the bikes were new and the driving conditions bad, today I guess the bikes are old but the conditions are good, no doubt as challenging as it was then, but just under different conditions.

The 2015 DJ, has still attracted good numbers possibly exceeding 100 once again proving that the event is not losing its lustre. The DJ remains and will remain, thanks to the organisers and participants, the oldest annual motoring event in South Africa.

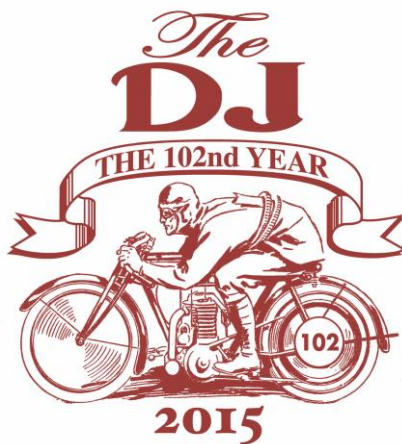

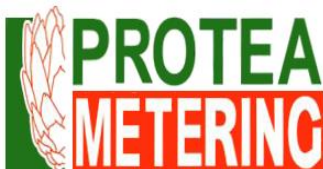
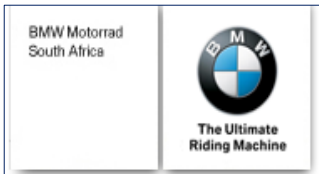
